Re: EPIC Imaging and Body Imaging Radiology

Dear Mr. Jackson,

I am writing on behalf of Drs. Meunier and Warnock and Body Imaging and EPIC Imaging, located in Portland and Beaverton, Oregon. I am very disappointed to learn that neither Body Imaging nor EPIC will be an option for our Providence-insured patients as of May 1, 2005. I have used the services of these facilities extensively as the point of service for X-ray and MRI for my patients as I provide neither service in my own clinic. Therefore, I strongly urge Providence to reconsider their decision to eliminate these providers from their contracted networks.

Body Imaging radiologists have always been extremely helpful and available to discuss questions regarding films taken at their facility. Additionally, they are the closest facility to my clinic which is of considerable convenience to patients.

The staff at EPIC, including the radiologists, are exceptionally helpful and cooperative both for me with professional queries, and for my patients. Additionally, they have chiropractic radiologists on staff, a feature not available within the Providence system. Chiropractic interpretation of X-ray is of significant benefit to my patients for obvious reasons. I rely heavily on the expertise of these radiologists to include the chiropractic and structural interpretation as well as the standard medical interpretations. Over the years, their services have been exemplary.

I ask that Providence reinstate both facilities as eligible providers for the Providence system.
